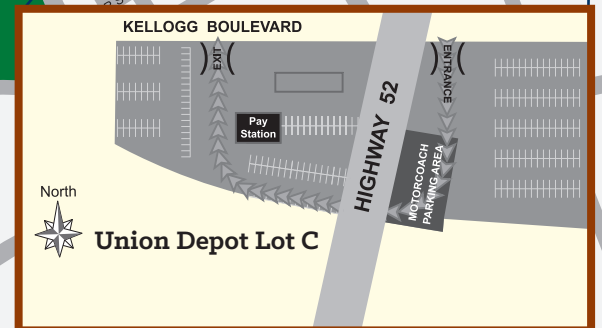
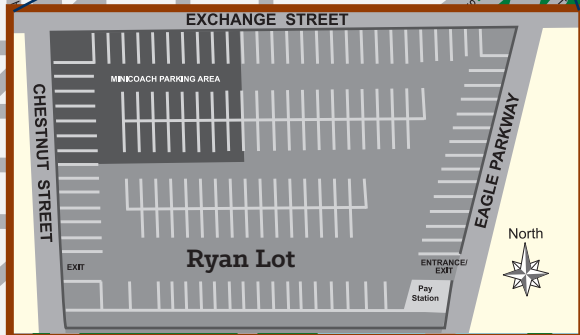

## Motorcoach Parking Day & Overnight

Union Depot Lot C East offers day and overnight bus parking with in/out privileges for \$40 per day. The lot is patrolled and open 24 hours, 7 days a week. Please pull in and park in the lot to the East of the Lafayette Bridge. Call ABM Parking services at 651-202-2741 for more information. 72 hour notice is required.

## Returning to Downtown (From Union Depot Lot C)

## Mini-Coach Parking Only (18-31 passenger vehicles)

ImPark's Ryan Lot offers day only mini-coach parking for \$5 per parking stall (ex. if you use 3 parking stalls, purchase 3 - \$5 parking tickets). The patrolled lot is open to mini-coaches only from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, 7 days a week. Please use the far northwest corner of the parking lot (corner closest to Exchange Street and Chestnut Street). Please notify them of your arrival by calling 651-224-2139 or e-mailing [jnelson@impark.com](mailto:jnelson@impark.com) 24 hours in advance.

## Reserving Meters for Bus Parking

A Right-of-Way (ROW) Meter Hooding permit is required whenever meters need to be reserved. This permit can be requested by calling our main ROW permit desk number at 651-266-6151.

Meters are reserved on a first-pay-basis. Request must be made at least 24 hours in advance. Payment for permits can be made over the phone with a credit card. All "contractors" wishing to obtain permits in Saint Paul must provide evidence of adequate general liability insurance naming the City of Saint Paul as additional insured and be registered with the ROW Division.

Currently the cost components for Meter Hooding permits are as follows:

- \$43.50 Labor (one-time charge for any quantity of meters from 1-12), the next group (13-24) is an additional \$43.50, and so on.
- \$6.00 Reservation Fee for each meter per day, 7 days per week and holidays.
- \$2.00 Lost Revenue per hour, per meter 8AM-6PM, Mon-Sat and \$1.00 per hour, per meter 6PM-10PM.

Total Cost per meter per 24 hour day = \$30.00 each in the downtown area, plus the \$43.50 laborcharge (1-12 meters).

## Free On-Street Day Parking

Free, on-street, day parking is available on the following areas of Fillmore and State Streets:

- From the west drive of River Park Plaza to State St (north side)
- On the south side of Fillmore from the west drive of River Park Plaza to Eva St
- On the south side of Fillmore from State St to Lafayette Frontage Rd W
- On the east side of State St from Fillmore towards Plato Blvd
- On the west side of Lafayette Frontage Rd W from Fillmore towards Plato Blvd.



All approved on-street, free motorcoach parking areas will be indicated by one of these signs. If you do not see one of these signs, do not park at that location. See the map and key for approved on-street parking areas.
